General Inspectorate for Immigration offers you the opportunity to submit on-line, 24/7, for extension of the temporary stay right for studies by accessing the website <a href="http://igi.mai.gov.ro/">http://igi.mai.gov.ro/</a>.



This procedure allows us to get a preview to your documents and if all the conditions of form and content are met, you will be informed within 48 houres, to your e-mail address, regarding the date and time of your appointment at our counters.

By using this facility you can upload the appropriate documents for the purpose for which you want to extend your stay right and an employee of General Inspectorate for Immigration will be able to send you an response to your request.

This way you will save time by obtaining the necessary information without the need to go to the headquarters of our institution and you will be able to submit your documents at the counter at the established date and time in 15 minutes or less.

At the same time, if you need any information regarding:

- -G.E.O. no.194/2002 regarding the regim of foreign citizens in Romania, republished;
- -G.E.O. no. 102/2005 regarding the free movement of citizens of the European Union, European Economic Area or Swiss Confederation, republished,
- -G.O. no. 25/2014 regarding the employment and secondment of foreigners in Romania , you can obtain it by submitting your request at the e-mail address <a href="mailto:dimb.igi@mai.gov.ro">dimb.igi@mai.gov.ro</a> . and we will respond in the shortest time possible.

At the same time, the students from the European Union have the legal obligation to apply for and obtain a registration certificate from the Directorate for Immigration Bucharest - the headquarters from Nicolae Iorga street, no. 23, in order to obtain the residence right for a period that will exceed three months.
